The COA event will be held at Lake O' Pine's Brushy Creek area. These hunts are managed hunts and harvests are limited due to the guidelines, rules, and regulations set forth by the Corps of Engineers and Texas Parks and Wild life dept.

COA and the Corps of Engineers are co-host to these events. It is understood that all guidelines will be followed by each participant. Each participant is a representative of COA and the participants actions could affect the partner relationship held between COA and the Corps of Engineers. Therefore, any participant who fails to comply with any and all of the rules and regulations will be automatically dismissed from participating in the hunt.

Rules and Regulations
Challenged Hunt

ALL TPWD and all US Corps of Engineers rules must be followed.

- All hunters and guardians must stay in their assigned areas until picked up by a COA representative.
- COA events are fair chase events. A successful harvest is not guaranteed.
- Firearms are to be loaded only during hunting in the deer blind.
- All participants must sign a release form and it must be received by COA prior to the event.
- All participants must sign a Liability Release Form prior to the event.
- Each participant will be allowed to harvest game according to the regulations of the state. This information will be supplied to you by your guide or COA representative prior to the hunt.
- You must obtain a hunting license. This charge is your responsibility.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES or ILLEGAL DRUGS ON PROPERTY.** *You will be promptly escorted off the property if in possession.*
- Lunch and Supper will be provided.

PLEASE NOTE: There may be film crews on hand for filming, as well as media personnel to conduct interviews. By signing the Liability/News Release Form you agree to allow yourself to be photographed or interviewed at any time. COA has developed the Rules and Regulations Understanding Statement so all involved understand their roles and responsibilities.

If you are approved to hunt Friday afternoon be at Public Pavilion of Brushy Creek Recreation Area of Lake o' the Pines no earlier than 12 noon and no later than 2 pm that Friday December 17th, 2009

If you are approved to hunt either Saturday Dec. 18th or Sunday Dec. 19th be at the Public Pavilion of Brushy Creek Recreation Area of Lake o' the Pines no later than 5 am that Saturday or Sunday.

We will make contact with you before your hunt date to let you know you are approved for the hunt. It will be by phone if possible. Other means will be attempted if unable to contact you by phone.
